- We will also be adding more of Gordon Richards' very popular historical articles that are published in the local Truckee newspaper The Sierra Sun.



TRUCKEE DONNER HISTORICAL SOCIETY ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP REPORT RECAP SEPTEMBER 26, 2006 Presented at the Annual Election Dinner held at The Lodge at Tahoe Donner

Our overall membership numbers increased by over 11 percent this past year. The largest increase in total numbers seen in many years.

We saw:

- > An increase in Business, Complimentary, Family, In-Kind, and Individual memberships
- > A decrease in Contributing, Junior, and Lifetime memberships,
- > No change in total numbers for the Honorary and Non-Profit memberships

There were 47 new memberships within the past year. Twelve existing members elected to change their membership types.

The following members volunteered to pay annual membership dues in lieu of receiving a *non-fee* membership:

- Barbara Green paid for an individual membership in lieu of an *Honorary* membership as provided elected officials.
- Truckee-Tahoe Lumber Company paid for a Contributing membership after the board had voted to provide an In-Kind membership for roofing supplies donated at their cost for the research cabin in the 2005 summer.
- Moonshine Ink continues to pay for a Business membership in lieu of a Complimentary membership normally granted to local publishers.

The Society is very appreciative for their elective decision to help support the Society with their annual membership dues.

Complimentary memberships were granted to the Lahontan Community Foundation and the Truckee Tahoe Community Foundation for grants made to upgrade the roof and exterior of our research cabin and In-Kind memberships were provided to individuals and companies who donated supplies and/or manpower for the cabin improvements.

On a sad note each year is the passing-away of members. I'd like to honor the memory of three of our members during the past year, Dennis Cowan, Tim Fix and Eva Besio. Our heartfelt condolences go out to their families. The Society knows the positive impacts each member made upon our community, which will continue to live on.
